CULTURAL VISIT TO A SAMBURU VILLAGE



Experience the vibrant Samburu culture, an essential part of any visit. Discover their traditions and customs while participating in daily life alongside Samburu women—from milking animals to preparing traditional meals. 12km Drive Time: 20mins (approx)

BUSH WALK

SHARED GAME DRIVE



Samburu National Reserve is renowned for its unique "Samburu Special 5" species, endemic to Northern Kenya. These include the rare Grevy's Zebra, Somali Ostrich, Beisa Oryx, Gerenuk, and the beautiful reticulated giraffes.

Opt for an AM or PM game drive to experience the difference. (Min 2pax -shared)

SAMBURU VILLAGE

Discover a unique matriarchal village near Archer's Post in Samburu County. Founded in 1990, this community serves as a sanctuary for women escaping abuse.

The village champions women's rights, actively campaigning against female genital mutilation (FGM) and providing shelter to at-risk girls. Residents support themselves through traditional handcraft production.

(Minimum 2 people, 2-hour visit)

SINGING WELL

Witness the mesmerizing Singing Wells ritual, a cornerstone of Samburu culture. Watch as Samburu warriors form a living chain, descending into deep wells carved from parched riverbeds. Their harmonious chants echo across the landscape, coordinating their movements as they pass water upwards, bucket by bucket.

(14km Drive: 30 mins approx)

FULL DAY EXCURSION TO RETETI ELEPHANT SANCTUARY



Explore a community-managed elephant sanctuary in Samburu County. Established in 2016, it cares for orphaned and abandoned calves. Your visit supports the conservation efforts of these vulnerable creatures.
